Village residents will have an opportunity to dispose of many large items that are not normally accepted for regular curbside garbage pickup. Items may be delivered to the parking area behind the Fall River Municipal Building between the hours of 9 am and 12 pm *on this date only*. There will be a disposal charge for each item.
